CODE OF CONDUCT

“Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ...”
Philippians 1:27

FAITH Home School, Inc., herein referred to as FAITH, is a Christian organization. As such, it is our earnest desire that the actions and attitudes of our members give glory and honor to God through our Lord Jesus Christ. The rules contained herein have been put in place to guide us in this endeavor. Please read carefully. You and your family are responsible for knowing and abiding by all the guidelines herein.

Erath County Cowboy Church has graciously allowed FAITH to hold co-op classes in their facilities. When using the church’s facilities, we must conduct ourselves with all wisdom and consideration for this great gift God has provided for our group.

- Students must be supervised at all times.
- You may not drop off your students at co-op without leaving them in the care of an adult. Students who drive themselves to co-op are the exception to this rule; this exception is a privilege which can be revoked by the board if behavior so dictates.
- While at co-op students must be either in class or Study Hall. Loitering in the hallway or parking lot is not allowed.
- The speed limit is 15mph. No speeding or spinning tires.
- The playground area must be supervised by an adult.
- Students and adults must keep noise to a minimum inside the building.
- Students must show respect and obedience to all adults.
- Students must avoid the church offices; they conduct the business of the church during class periods and must not be distracted.
- Classrooms should be left in better condition than the way they were found. Each person is responsible for picking up his or her trash. Go the extra mile here, bless the church and glorify the Lord!
- Study Hall is to be a quiet place for school work only.
- Children must not bounce balls or throw objects in the nursery.
- The backroom of the nursery is to be kept available for nursing and sleeping babies.

Disciplinary Measures:

When an adult addresses an issue with a student, if he/she responds respectfully and corrects the problem, no further action will be taken. If the student responds disrespectfully and does not correct the problem, or if the offense is considered serious by the observing adult, the following procedure will be implemented:

First Offense: Parents of the student will be notified, and will take appropriate action to correct the issue.

Second Offense: The student will be suspended from co-op classes and activities for such a time as the Board deems necessary.

Third Offense: The student will be restricted from all FAITH classes, sports and activities for the remainder of the school year. **Membership fees will not be refunded.**
